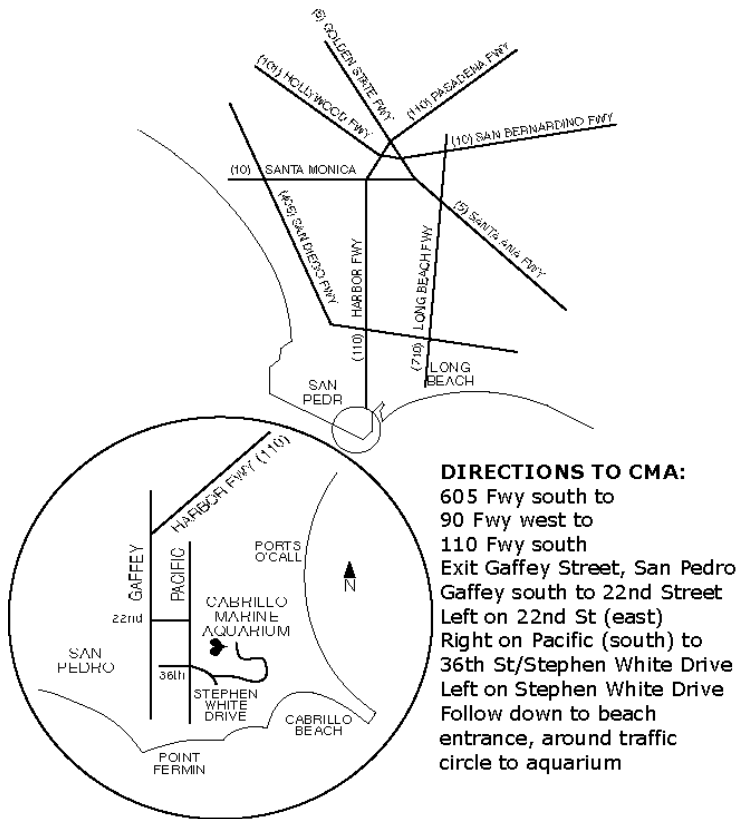

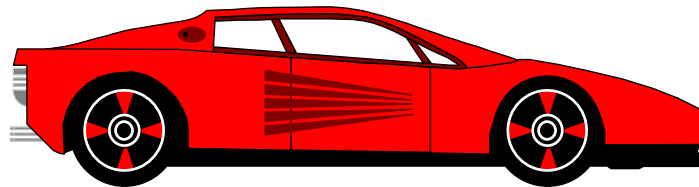
Cars should weigh around 5 ounces at turn in. Weight will be added by track officials to get cars to no more than 6 oz.
