Egg Drop Eggstravaganza!!

The Egg Drop is an exciting parent-son experiment in "engineering"

The Goal: Don't break Humpty!!!

The Preparation: The boys should design their apparatus for the egg drop, either at home, or at a group meeting. **DO NOT SEAL** the container until **AFTER** it has been inspected at the check in table. Use your best judgment for the materials used.

The Check-In: Every Scout must check-in at **9pm sharp** (location to be determined)! Please note all cars must pay \$8 for their game parking pass. Cars will be directed to park in parking lots TBA.

The Egg Event: The event will begin at **9:45am!** Each scouts' entry will be dropped off a location TBA by assigned personnel. Each box that is dropped must be retrieved and turned back into the registration table for inspection. All participants will receive a Dodger/ Boy Scout goody upon checkout. The event will end at **11:15am** for clean-up.

"What can we do from 11:15 until the game starts?"

- ***Batting practice** will take place and your pavilion seats are the best place to catch **homerun balls?**
- *The Scouts' whose egg did not break will be **introduced on the field during pre-game.**
- *Those participating will be given instructions for-game following their drop.
- *Concessions and merchandising stands might be open for service.

Egg Dropping Rules

- ⇒ In order to participate in the Egg Drop a Boy Scout's troop will have sold 30 or more tickets to the August 21st game. Tickets may include an entire troop, family members and friends.
- ⇒ This is a great program for fundraising
- ⇒ Your Scout must have a ticket for the August 21st game.
- ⇒ Each troop must have at least one chaperone in attendance at the Egg Drop.
- ⇒ The largest box size allowed is 14" x 14".
- ⇒ Each package must be clearly marked with the scout's name.
- ⇒ All boxes will be inspected inside and out before the competition, **MAKE SURE THE BOX IS NOT SEALED UNTIL AFTER INSPECTION** (bring extra supplies for sealing).
- ⇒ All Scouts involved in the Egg Drop must fill out a release form.
- ⇒ Scouts must provide their own raw egg.
